writer's statement

Three actresses on set, Silvia Costa, Barbara Lennie alternating with Itsaso Arana, and Audrey Bonnet, reclaim the mystery of the annunciation played out between the virgin Marie and the angel Gabriel.

Each of them speaking in her mother language. Three monologues, in Italian, Spanish, French. Three performative speeches dig this groove to question it today, to draw it towards the side of modernity. In this device, the public becomes the depositary of the revelation, it is in a position to receive, in the listening state of the Virgin. What could we announce in our time? What could be the contemporary annunciation? The ecological disaster to come? The end of the world? The advent of new times? Reverse gear?

Everything is open and imagination prevails.

interview of Pascal Rambert (1/3)

**Interview of Pascal Rambert with the journalist Marie Plantin
(2019 september 12th)**

Foreword : To be clear, this text is not a briefing note in strictly correct form but is it not sometimes more appropriate to take liberties with conventional style? This presentation of "3annonciations " comes after a phone call I had with Pascal Rambert last September (Sept 12th2019). Today, I try to communicate what I understood of the artist's intention. I listened closely to his words and here, take liberty to speak for him.

The story starts three years or so ago. With an artist like Pascal Rambert, the idea of a new play gushes out of his imagination, not as a sudden unexpected discovery, or 'eureka' shout, but rather as an idea which was already at work in his mind, and suddenly springs up from the depth of his imagination. An idea to be translated into a play, a text to be logically performed on stage. It is a constant feature with Pascal Rambert. Every new play is related to one or several of his former plays, and every new play opens the scope for a new one. Each creation resounds with the echoes of the past creations. It is as if "3annonciations "had been budding in the writer's imagination, waiting for the right time to open up and develop into a text and stage performance, with actors standing on stage and addressing the public.

So it happened three years ago. Pascal Rambert was in Venice and the least one can say is that the places he visits, or where he stops for some time during his personal or professional travels, have a strong impact on his creation. Geographic places give nerve and richness to his inspiration. Places have a strong effect on characters and their destiny. Geography teams up with history, like two sisters who cannot live separately, like the two sides of the same coin.

So it took place in Venice, during the "biennial". Pascal Rambert was invited to lead a masterclass with young artists from all over the world. He took them from church to church, to discover the ever-flowing spring of Italian art and in particular, one of the most mysterious and fascinating themes; the scene of the Annunciation. Together, they fall under the spell of the bewildering force of these paintings. A priceless treasure to use on stage and choreography, the Annunciation scene tells a powerful story, and even more than the exchange between Angel Gabriel and Virgin Mary, it is their physical postures and positioning in space which inspired the improvisations of the dancers and performers. They were a creative group, full of inspiration; taking hold of the mystery of Annunciation, they tried to give it a new interpretation in the modern light of XX1 st century Venice.

interview of Pascal Rambert (2/3)

What could one announce today? What could be predicted with regard to the world? The ecological catastrophe to come? The end of the world? The dawning of a new era? It is an open field for the imagination.

It took place at the biennial of Venice. The high place of art production, the place where artists flock from all over the world and meet around all sorts of artistic exhibitions. Romeo Castellucci attended it as well as Silvia Costa, who was his right – hand person, muse, assistant and stage director for several years. Both of them worked in Pascal Rambert's workshop; so the two stage directors met and decided to work together. Rambert and Castellucci, who would have believed it? Yet it suddenly made sense, two personalities and a common subject and direction, working ahead to build a stage performance on The Annunciation.

Autumn 2019. The project has taken shape. Pascal Rambert has now got the structure of the play. On stage, Silvia Costa, an Italian actress who once worked with Pascal Rambert in Theatre de Gennevilliers when Pascal Rambert was the manager, Barbara Lennie, the Spanish actress in "Cloture de l'amour" and "soeurs " in their Spanish versions, and Audrey Bonnet, the key actress in all his plays. Three actresses that the stage director wanted to have on the same cast, this is what he usually does with actors that he appreciates and wants to see together on stage, embarked on the same ship.

This is what we know at this stage in the writing of the play, "3annonciations." Three monologues to come; three individual performances raising the question of language, which is a regular concern with Pascal Rambert. The power of language, ranging between destructive violence and love, with words desperately trying to explain the world and failing to do so. Each of these three women, will, in turn, embody the Angel Gabriel. The angel will address each of the spectators in the familiar "tu" making them the individual recipient of the Annunciation. Each of these women will be receptive to the message, as was the Virgin. These voices sound like inner voices, as when one speaks to oneself, but they reach out to all the spectators, to be shared by others. The message they receive is both personal, and public.

These three monologues will be given in three languages, the three mother tongues of the actresses, and they might even mix in the three final scenes.

Pascal Rambert has a great habit of juggling with languages. He has been working on the international scene for many years, but it is the first time he is working in three languages at the same time, on the same project.

interview of Pascal Rambert (3/3)

The play will be divided into three parts of equal importance: around 30 minutes for each one. The play will last around 1h 30, a rather classical time. Three separate pictures or sequences, featuring three different places and times in history. Three acts: the first one being the closest to the famous Italian Quattrocento, that splendid era of art history, a period lost in time with its dreams of beauty and invention of very elaborate and refined pictorial art works, painted with utmost precision and care. The second act will be set in Spain, during the Holy week; It will express the ardent devotion, blood and passion, and the overwhelming beauty of the Good Friday procession. It is rooted in times to come, in the human quest to understand the world, and its metaphysical need for answers. As for the last act, it will be set in a remote future, may be in space and in the presence of a cosmonaut. Somehow the play will follow the pace of the world, starting in the past and heading towards the future, and into the unknown. Yet this time, connection will deliberately remain unclear, as if the scene were seen through a slightly dirty magnifying glass, as if things were happening behind a veil. Concerning the different roles in the conception of the play, they have, in principle, been dealt this way: Pascal Rambert for text writing, stage and actresses' direction; Romeo Castellucci in charge of scenography of which there will be a day to day adaptation when it comes to the concrete work on stage. The idea is that Pascal will share his intuitions with Romeo and tell him what he wants to communicate. Romeo will have to integrate these ideas and translate them into visual scenes according to his own conception of the project. From words to pictures, each of them will connect to his partner's ideas, and this is how the project will become real.

This is how a common project, imagined and carried out by two major artists recognized for their strong identities, will find its shape and resolution.

"3annonciations" is in its first impulse, but it is already in the wave which will carry it forward to its realization. "3annonciations" is still a budding project full of unanswered questions, but this period in time, just before two desires meet to build something together, is a rich field for discoveries and promises.

biography of Pascal Rambert (1/3)

Pascal Rambert is a French writer, choreographer, and director for the stage and screen. He was born in 1962. In 2016 he receives the "Grand prix de l'Académie Française pour l'ensemble de son oeuvre" / "Theater Prize from Académie Française for his entire body of work".

From January 2017 he has been the partner artist at the Théâtre des Bouffes du Nord in Paris, at El Pavón Teatro Kamikaz from September 2017 and from 2014 the partner playwright at the National Theatre of Strasbourg.

For 10 years, 2007–2016, he served as the Director of TG2-Théâtre de Gennevilliers, which he has transformed into a national dramatic center for contemporary creation, exclusively devoted to living artists (theater, dance, opera, contemporary art, film, and philosophy).

Rambert's theatre plays and choreographies have been produced by structure, supported by the French Ministry of Culture and Communication, and staged in Europe, North America, Asia, Russia, South America, Middle East.

His writing (theater, stories, and poetry) is published in France with the press Solitaires Intempestifs and has been translated, published, and staged in many languages: English, Russian, Italian, German, Japanese, Chinese, Croatian, Slovenian, Polish, Portuguese (from Portugal and from Brazil), Spanish (Mexican and Argentinian), Castilian, Catalan, Dutch, Czech, Thai, Dansk and Greek.

His dance pieces, including the most recent, *Memento Mori*, created in 2013 with the lighting designer Yves Godin, have been performed at major festivals and contemporary dance festivals: Montpellier, Avignon, Utrecht, Berlin, and Hamburg as well as New York, Tokyo and Los Angeles.

Pascal Rambert has directed several operas in France and in the United States. The short films he has directed have been selected and awarded at festivals in Pantin, Locarno, Miami, and Paris.

His play *Clôture de l'amour* (Love's End), created at the 65th Festival d'Avignon in 2011 with Audrey Bonnet and Stanislas Nordey, was an international success. The script won the prize for public theater in the Theater 2013 – Dithea competition, the prize for best new French-language play from the Syndicat de la Critique (Critics' Union) in 2012, and the Grand Prize for dramatic literature from the Centre national du théâtre (National Theater Center) in October, 2012. In 2017, *Clôture de l'amour* was staged more than 180 times in France and much more all over the world, and translated in 23 languages. Pascal Rambert has adapted *Clôture de l'amour* into eleven languages: for the Moscow Art Theatre; in New York, Zagreb, Modena, and Rome, and at Milan's Piccolo Teatro; in Shizuoka, Osaka, and Yokohama; in Berlin and at the Thalia Theater in Hamburg; in Barcelona at the Grec Festival and in Madrid at the Festival de Otoño; and in Copenhagen, Aalborg, Aarhus, and Odense, in Mandarin in China in Beijing, in Arabic in Cairo in Egypt, in Finnish in Finland, Helsinki.

biography of Pascal Rambert (2/3)

Pascal Rambert created *Une (micro) histoire économique du monde, dansée* (A (mi-cro) history of world economics, danced) at T2G, Théâtre de Gennevilliers, in 2010. After its French tour, Rambert has adapted the work for further performances in Japan; in Hamburg and Karlsruhe, Germany; in the United States in New York, Los Angeles and Pittsburgh; and in Cairo, Egypt.

His play *Avignon à vie* (Avignon for Life), read by Denis Podalydès, was first staged at the 2013 67th Festival d'Avignon in the Cour d'Honneur du Palais des Papes.

His most recent play, *Répétition* (Rehearsal), written for Emmanuelle Béart, Audrey Bonnet, Denis Podalydès of the Comédie Française, Stanislas Nordey, and Claire Zeller, premiered December 12, 2014 at T2G, Théâtre de Gennevilliers- national dramatic center for contemporary creation as part of Festival d'Automne in Paris. It was afterward performed in Lyon and toured nationally and internationally in the fall of 2015.

At the end of 2016, he directed the Italian version of the play, *Prova*, at the Teatro Arena del Sole de Bologna and at the Piccolo Teatro di Milano, and in 2017 *Ensayo* the Spanish version in Madrid. For *Répétition* (Rehearsal) Pascal Rambert was awarded from the French Academy with the annual prize 2015 of literature and philosophy.

In June, 2015, in the bare space of the Bouffes du Nord Theater in Paris, Rambert presented five of his plays: *Memento Mori*, *Clôture de l'amour* (Love's end), *Avignon à vie* (Avignon for life), *De mes propres mains* (With My Own Hands) and *Libido Sciendi*.

In January, 2016, he did premier his play *Argument*, written for Laurent Poitreaux and Marie-Sophie Ferdane, at the CDN (National Theater Center) Orléans / Loiret / Centre, then present it at La Comédie in Reims and at T2G, Théâtre de Gennevilliers - national dramatic center for contemporary creation.

In May 2017 at the Théâtre du Vieux Colombiers in Paris, he directed the text *Une vie* (A life) that he wrote for the actors of the Comédie-Française in Paris. In August 2017, he has written GHOSTs for some Taiwanese actors, he directed it for the opening of the Performing Art Festival in Taipei.

He wrote *Actrice* (Actress) for the actors of the Art Theater of Moscow, and he created it on December 12nd 2017 at the Théâtre des Bouffes du Nord in Paris, starred Marina Hands, Audrey Bonnet, Jakob Öhrman, Elmer Bäck, Rasmus Slätis, Jean Guizerix, Emmanuel Cuchet, Ruth Nüesch, Luc Bataïni, Lyna Khoudri, Yuming Hey, Sifan Shao, Laetitia Somé, and alternately, Anas Abidar, Nathan Aznar et Samuel Kircher. *Actrice* toured in France from January to March 2018.

He wrote *Reconstitution* in march 2018 for and with Vero Dahuron and Guy Delamotte from the Panta Theatre in Caen.

He wrote *Nos Parents* (Our Parents) for the student actors of the Manufacture in Lausanne that he directed in April 2018.

In september 2018, he stages his play *Christine* at the Comédie de Genève during the Festival Julie's Party, then creates Teatro at the Teatro Nacional Dona Maria II in Lisbon, starring Beatriz Batarda, Cirila Bossuet, João Grosso, Lúcia Maria, Rui Mendes.

In November 2018, he directed *Soeurs* (Sisters) written for Marina Hands and Audrey Bonnet. In December, he directed the spanish version, *Hermanas*, with Barbara Lennie and Irene Escolar.

In February 2019, he staged *Glumica*, the Croatian version of *Actrice* with the actors of the National Theater of Zagreb.

From February to June 2019, he has been Visiting Belknap Fellow in the Humanities and Visiting Lecturer in French and Italian with Florent Masse at Princeton University, New Jersey. By May 2019, he directed the students in his play *Other's*. In March 2019, he created 愛的落幕, the Taiwanese version of *Clôture de l'Amour* at the Metropolitan Theater of Taipei.

In June 2019, he created *Mont Vérité* with the TNS school students for the Printemps des Comédiens Festival.

His play *Architecture*, written for Emmanuelle Béart, Audrey Bonnet, Anne Brochet, Marie-Sophie Ferdane, Arthur Nauzyciel, Stanislas Nordey, Denis Podalydès, Laurent Poitrenaux, Pascal Rénéric and Jacques Weber, will be premiered at the Festival d'Avignon in 2019 (Cour d'Honneur du Palais des Papes).

In November 2019, he created *Rakkauden Päätös*, the finnish version of *Clôture de l'amour* at the Finnish National Theater of Helsinki (Finland).

In February 2020, he created *Desaparecer* in Mexico (UNAM, Mexico city).

He will create in septembre 2020 *3 annonces* with Audrey Bonnet (FR), Sd Barbara Lennie alternating Itsaso Arana (ES).

biographies of the actresses

Audrey Bonnet (FR)

Audrey Bonnet is an alumnae of the Conservatoire National Supérieur d'Art Drama-tique in Paris. She was part of the repertory company at the Comédie Française from 2003 to 2006. On stage, she has performed in the works of Shakespeare, Kol-tès, Fosse, Maeterlinck, Claudel, Marivaux, Pessoa, Euripide, Duras, and Pascal Rambert, among others. She has worked with directors from a range of diverse backgrounds, from Bob Wilson to Luc Bondy, Roland Auzet to D' de Kabal, Oriza Hirata to Yves-Noël Genod. Deeply connected to the Compagnie des Petits Champs, directed by Clément Hervieu Léger and Daniel San Pedro, she has performed with them the works of Marivaux, Lorca, and in 2018 and 2019 *Le Pays Lointain* by Jean-Luc Lagarce, directed by Clément Hervieu Léger. For the Opera, she performs in the work of Romeo Castellucci (*Jeanne au Bucher*), composed by Arthur Honegger, Paul Claudel 's livret (currently on tour worldwide). Since her key encounter with Pascal Rambert in 2001, their relationship has kept maturing in *Le Début de l'A*, *Répétition*, *Actrice* and *Clôture de l'amour* (currently on tour worldwide). For *Clôture de l'amour*, she received the award for the Best Actress at the *Palmarés du Théâtre* in 2013. She is an associate artist at the National Theater of Strasbourg, directed by Stanislas Nordey. On the screen, she can be seen in *Personal Shopper* by Olivier Assayas, *The End* by Guillaume Nicloux, *Jeune Femme* by Léonor Serraille and recently in *Un Peuple Et Son Roi* by Pierre Schoell.

Silvia Costa (IT)

Graduated in 2006 in Visual Arts and Theater at the IUAV University in Venice, she began working as an actress with the Societas Raffaello Sanzio for the production *Hey Girl!* Since then, she has contributed as an artistic collaborator to all the theatrical and lyrical productions of Romeo Castellucci. By turns author, director, performer or scenographer, this multifaceted artist uses all artistic fields to lead her exploration of the theater.

Bárbara Lennie (SP)

Bárbara Lennie is an actress. She played in *La piel que habito* by Pedro Almodóvar (2011), *La niña de fuego* by Carlos Vermut (2014), a role which has won her numerous awards in Spain, including the Goya for best actress, the *Fotogramas de Plata* and the Medal of the *Círculo de Escritores Cinematográficos*, *Everybody knows* by Asghar Farhadi (2018). In Spain, she is also known for her role of Joan of Portugal in the *Isabel* series. Pascal Rambert created *Hermanas* (2018) for her, the Spanish version of *Soeurs*.

Itsaso Arana (SP)

Itsaso Arana is an actress and screenwriter. She notably starred with Jonás Trubea in *La Reconquista* (2016) and *Eva* in *August* (2019), a film which won the best screenplay awards at *Cinespana 2019*.
